



## Scholarship Application

Waterville Playshop awards scholarships each year to recognize students or their families who have been active in Playshop for at least 2 years, who exhibit a supportive attitude toward community theatre, and are a positive role model in the performing arts.

Students must be accepted or enrolled in an accredited post-secondary program for the upcoming school year. The Board of Trustees reviews the applications and selects a student or students to receive the award. The Scholarship Award is announced at the annual meeting.

To be eligible for the Scholarship, the following criteria must be met:

- Be a high school senior, accepted into an accredited post-secondary program or a college student, currently enrolled in an accredited post-secondary program.
- Applicant or family must have participated in Waterville Playshop activities.
- Applicant must have participated in community theatre in some capacity.

**Requirements:** The completed application package must include the following items:

1. Application form
2. Copy of University/College Acceptance Letter or Registration Form
3. A current official transcript—high school or college (remove Social Security Number)
4. A current resume
5. Two letters of reference Response to questions

The scholarship will be presented at the Annual Meeting of Waterville Playshop. *The recipient or designee must be present to receive the award or forfeit the scholarship.*

The letters of reference may be from anyone of your choosing who is not related to your family. Possible suggestions for the letter include, a high school teacher, college professor, director, or a performing arts coach (i.e., a dance instructor, drama coach, vocal or instrumental coach, etc.).

**Questions:** The following five questions/statements should be answered and typed on 8 ½" x 11" paper using a 10 or 12-point font. Each question should be answered on a separate sheet of paper, double spaced, and have one-inch margins. You may use only one sheet per question. In the header of each page include your name and question number.

1. Why do you want this scholarship and how will it benefit you?
2. What do you believe are the benefits that community theaters provide to the community at large?
3. What benefits did you, personally, derive from being a part of community theater?
4. What activities (clubs, organizations, community groups, work experience, etc.) have you participated that will help you succeed in your chosen career path?  
**Describe your involvement.**
5. List any scholarships, awards, or honors have you received. Be sure to **describe** what the purpose of each is.
