

Waterville Playshop's *We Wish You a Broadway Christmas!* Audition Information and Expectations ☺

Thank you for auditioning for Waterville Playshop's production of *We Wish You a Broadway Christmas!* Before you audition, please note the needed information and individual responsibilities that accompany a role in the show.

Rehearsal Dates: Please see calendar on the reverse side of this page for information. These dates are all potential, dependent upon cast availability; not all of them will be rehearsal dates. As soon as the cast is assembled with conflicts tabulated, a final rehearsal schedule will be sent to all participants. Rehearsals will occur at the Playshop building, but final dress and the show will be performed at Zion Lutheran Church. Dress rehearsal is on December 10; and the performances are December 11 and 12, both at 7:30 pm.

Cast Notification: All those auditioning will be notified about cast/role/skit placement via email. This is the quickest, most cost effective way for us to contact you. If you do not have an email address, you will be notified by phone or letter per request.

Materials (Costuming and Scripts): There is NO cost to participate in this show. The only request the directing staff has of you is that you will be responsible to supply your own simply costume(s) as designated by the director. If your part requires a more complex costume/outfit, Playshop will provide these materials. As far as scripts, everyone will receive a binder with a musical score. Following the final performance, you will need to return the scores. As this show is new, we need the materials back for copyright and development purposes.

Attendance: If you accept a part in this show, you will be expected to attend the rehearsals you marked as being able to attend. If you have to miss a rehearsal for whatever reason, please contact one of the directors; if you miss two or more rehearsals without informing one of the directors, you will be dropped from the show. Regardless, if you receive a role, you must be able to make at least 3 rehearsals in addition to the dress rehearsal and two performances. Every effort will be made to work with large groups first and then work with smaller ones; as stated, we will break the schedule down into even more detail for your convenience. If there is ever question as to the cancelation of a rehearsal due to questionable weather or some other emergency, please check email or call of one the directing staff.
