Thank you for auditioning for Waterville Playshop's production of *Monty Python's Spamalot*. Before you audition, please note the information/individual responsibilities that accompany a role in the show.

Rehearsal Dates: Please see calendar on the reverse side of this page for information (a more detailed schedule once the cast is set). Dates are minimally subject to change depending on availability of cast members. You will be notified well in advance if something changes with the schedule. This show will be performed at the Maumee Indoor Theatre on April 13, 14, and 15.

Cast Notification: All those auditioning will be notified whether you have made the cast via email. This is the quickest, most cost effective way for us to contact you. If you do not have an email address, you will be notified by phone or letter per request.

Costuming: The costume fee for any cast member that requires a costume is a non-refundable \$25. This is only a part of the cost as Waterville Playshop pays the balance. You will not be given a costume without payment of the fee. However, if you can find or build your own costume (per director's approval), any costume fee would be subsequently waived.

Scripts: If you require a script/chorus book, you MUST place a security deposit with Waterville Playshop equal to the value of the book (\$\(\frac{\(\xi\)}{35}\)) before you will be issued one. When the script/chorus book is returned, your security deposit will be refunded. You will not be allowed to participate in the show without a script/chorus book if your part requires one.

Attendance: If you accept a part in this show, you will be expected to attend rehearsals. If you have to miss a rehearsal for whatever reason, please contact one of the directors; if you miss two or more rehearsals without informing one of the directors, you will be dropped from the show. Regardless, if you receive a role, you must be able to make at least 95% of the rehearsals for which you are scheduled. Every effort will be made to work with large groups first and then work with smaller ones; as stated, we will break the schedule down into even more detail for your convenience. If there is ever question as to the cancelation of a rehearsal due to questionable weather or some other emergency, please check email or call of one the directing staff.

Rehearsal Space: We are proud new renters of our building, and we need to keep it clean and tidy. To that end, food and drink will be allowed in the rehearsal hall as long as individuals clean up after themselves (just not in the back room). Please do your part to keep things clean.
